- We offer an Early Bird Discount of 10% if you book before 16th February.
- We also offer a Sibling Discount of 10%. If you book for two children or more you pay the full price for one child and 10% off the course fees for every additional child.

Please be aware that we will just accept one discount per student. We won't be able to offer the Early Bird Discount where the Sibling Discount applies, sorry!

We need payment within a month of booking, or we won't be able to reserve your place!

### The accommodation cost covers the following dates:

Sunday, 26th July 2020 - Sunday, 16th August 2020

If you want to stay an extra night at the beginning or at the end of the course due to availability of flights, please let us know. Extra nights, when arriving earlier than 26 July, are charged at £20 per night; this extra amount is payable directly to the host family on arrival. Additional nights when departing later than 16 August are charged at £20 per night plus the Youth Hostel overnight accommodation fee; this extra amount is payable directly to us on arrival.

## How do I Pay?

Payment can be made by the following methods:

- Via bank transfer (you must ensure that all costs are payable by the sender and please keep a copy of the receipt in case of any problems with the payment arriving). Our bank details are stated on the Financial Agreement which you receive on submitting your application. **Please use your child's full name when transferring the payment so that we know who sent the money!**
- By MoneyGram (see [www.moneygram.com](http://www.moneygram.com) to find sending points near you). This works in a similar way to Western Union. Please email for details if you would like to pay this way.
- If you wish to pay by another method, such as TransferWise (see [www.transferwise.com](http://www.transferwise.com)) or similar websites, please email for advice.

**Please note:** We can no longer accept money by Western Union transfer, as our local branch has closed.

Students who withdraw from the course will only receive a refund if we are able to fill their place again. We are also sorry that we cannot give a price in Euros, as the exchange rate is so changeable. If it is cheaper for you to send the money in Euros, you can estimate how much this will be and it will be changed into pounds in our account. It will probably not be the exact amount, so we will tell you what the difference is, and that amount will be pay-able (or refunded) on arrival. Please consider transfer fees added by the bank.

We also ask that you transfer your payment with all the charges payable by the sender – we send you a receipt for the actual amount that arrives in our bank account.

All the expenses of the course and the stay are included in the course fee, so the only extra money you will need is for your child's own expenses – such as activities they may want to do in local towns and cities on the free days, postcards, stamps, souvenirs, cinema visits, extra 'treats' to eat (ice creams, chocolate etc.)!

Please note, on the trip to London or the day trips to Looe, Bantam and Exeter students may want to do some shopping, or visit attractions with entrance fees. It is worth researching the activities your child might like to do to find out if they need extra spending money for this.
